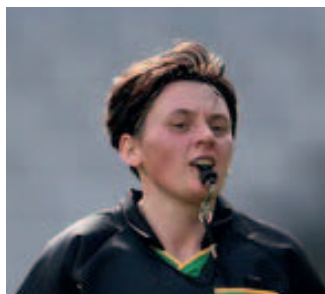
Ray Kelly Senior Final
